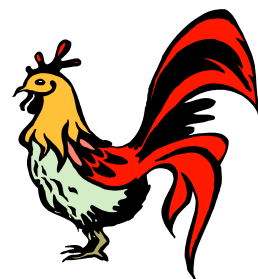

The following schedule contains the **Walk weekend time schedule for Fourth Day members**, including Sponsors. *These times are not necessarily the times of the events themselves.* (The Walk Manual contains a separate schedule for the Walk itself.) These times are for **FOURTH DAY MEMBERS**, so as to be in place when the pilgrims arrive for the specified events.

**FOURTH DAY WALK WEEKEND TIME SCHEDULE**

**THURSDAY - 6:15 TO 7:00 P.M.** - Pilgrims arrive with Sponsors. Sponsors and Pilgrims attend Snack Supper.

**THURSDAY - 7:15 P.M. TO 8:15 P.M.** - Walk Send-Off. Sponsors remain in Chapel for Sponsors' Hour, a time of prayer for the pilgrims.

**SATURDAY - 3:30 P.M.** - Designated Fourth Day arrive for Agape Dinner set-up.

**SATURDAY - 4:30 P.M.** - Additional Agape Dinner helpers arrive to cook and serve food. (Pilgrims arrive later.)

**SATURDAY - 8:15 P.M.** - Fourth Day, including all sponsors, arrive for Candlelight. (Pilgrims arrive later.)

**SUNDAY - 4:30 P.M.** - Fourth Day, including all sponsors, arrive for Closing. (Pilgrims arrive later.) **Sponsors pick up personal belongings of pilgrims and load cars PRIOR TO CLOSING.**

**SOME OTHER FOURTH DAY WALK WEEKEND REMINDERS:**

- Please be conscientious in observing the above times.
- Do NOT enter the Kaiserhof property on a Walk weekend unless you have a specific reason to be there.
- Remember that the Walk is a cloistered environment. At NO time should a Fourth Day member who is not a team member enter the Inn or the Conference Room.
- If you are involved in a Community Servanthood activity, please arrive at the time instructed by the Community Servanthood coordinators or the designated person in charge.
- Do not arrive early or stay longer than needed.
- If you need assistance with something, please contact the Walk Servant Team Coordinator or another Servant Team member.

## HNEC - SPONSOR'S CHECKLIST

### PRIOR TO WALK

- Attend sponsorship training.
- Pray for my pilgrim.
- Sign up for a designated prayer time slot on the Walk Prayer Clock.
- Answer any questions my pilgrim has.
- If my pilgrim is married, present the Walk to Emmaus to the spouse as well.
- Complete the Sponsor Application form and the Pilgrim Application form, and submit both to HNEC, along with the Walk fee payment.
- Write my own personal agape letter to my pilgrim.
- Obtain letters from 8-12 family members and close friends.
- Explain to my pilgrim what to bring to the Walk: Comfortable clothing and shoes, jacket, umbrella, flashlight, insect repellent, medications, personal items, extra bath towels.
- Explain to my pilgrim what NOT to bring to the Walk: Books, radios, clocks, watches, cell phones, pagers, PDAs, cameras, food.
- Make arrangements to take care of the pilgrim's personal responsibilities during the Walk weekend, such as child care, meals, house-sitting, pets, mail, plants, carpools, etc.



### WALK WEEKEND

#### **Thursday:**

- Pray for my pilgrim.
- Make sure I have my own personal agape letter for the pilgrim.
- Make sure I have the 8-12 letters from family members and close friends, including the pilgrim's spouse if he/she is married.
- Clearly mark the letters. In the upper left hand corner of all the envelopes, I have put who the letter is from (spouse, sponsor, child, close friend, etc.) In the center of all the envelopes, I have written the pilgrim's FIRST and LAST NAME.
- Pick my pilgrim up and have a light meal if necessary prior to arriving at Kaiserhof. (Snack supper consisting of finger foods is provided, but the pilgrim may want to eat prior to arriving.)
- Take my pilgrim to Kaiserhof, arriving between 6:15 and 7:00 p.m. on Thursday.
- Give the LETTERS and any AGAPE to the WALK TEAM at Check-In.
- Attend Send-Off and Sponsor's Hour from 7:15-8:15.

#### **Friday:**

- Pray for my pilgrim.

#### **Saturday:**

- Pray for my pilgrim.
- Attend Candlelight, arriving at Kaiserhof by 8:15 p.m.

#### **Sunday:**

- Pray for my pilgrim.
- Attend Closing, arriving at Kaiserhof by 4:30 p.m.
- Take my pilgrim home.
- Give any personal agape I may have to my pilgrim ON THE WAY HOME and NOT prior to the Walk.

### AFTER THE WALK:

- Pray for my pilgrim.
- Check on my pilgrim to see if they have questions and to make sure everything is OK.
- Help my pilgrim get established in a reunion accountability group.
- Bring my pilgrim to the scheduled Walk Follow-Up meeting and HNEC Community Gathering.

**Thursday Snack Supper** for team and arriving pilgrims and sponsors. Requires 6-8 people to arrive at 5 pm and provide food and service.

**Saturday Agape Dinner.** Requires 6-8 people to arrive at 3:30 p.m. and 8-12 people to arrive at 4:30 pm to cook, decorate, and serve.

**Saturday Candlelight Parking Attendants.** Requires 6-8 people to arrive at 7:30 and direct traffic.

**Saturday Candlelight Luminary Team.** Requires 5-6 people to arrive at 7:00 to set up luminaries and take them down after Candlelight service.

**Saturday Candlelight Service Team.** Requires 4-8 people to arrive at 6:30 to set up the service area, act as ushers, and help pass out candles. They will also assist in taking down the chairs in the service area after Candlelight.

**Rose Providers.** Requires the provision of 48 roses for Sunday on the women's walks only.

We have been asked in the last couple of years by many people if they needed to fill out new Team Service applications on a regular basis. Almost always the answer has been "NO".

However, we have started using a new Access database and have discovered that some information is old or incorrect. We would love to have your information **completely updated**. We don't necessarily need you to list all of your team service information, but we would like you to send in your current contact information, such as telephone numbers, email address, physical address and any other data you would like us to know.

Sending in a new Team Service application will also let us know that you **WANT** to work a Walk to Emmaus. Some of you have been on a Team Selection list and we just could not find your information, so please help us out and send that in. You can **download the form** off of the website and **print it out and send it in**. We know that this is the world of email, but in this case, **snail mail would really help us out**; we would also have that physical record to go back and look at in the future.



**Musicians, especially**, would you ladies and gentlemen send us an updated Team Selection application and **list the musical instruments you play well enough to play on a walk?** We would really appreciate it.

**SPONSORSHIP TRAINING & DAY SERVANT APPLICATION PROCESS****Houston North Emmaus Community  
Sponsorship Training Required for ALL HNEC Walks**

Sponsorship is THE most important role in the Walk to Emmaus. Therefore, the HNEC Board has implemented a Sponsorship Training initiative. Completion of this training is now required prior to the sponsorship of any pilgrim on any Walk. Yes, this means YOU.

Training sessions will be provided by the HNEC Board immediately prior to each HNEC community gathering. Board members (see Page 13) are available upon request to meet with your church's local Emmaus community and provide training in that setting. Local churches and reunion groups are encouraged to schedule sponsorship training in conjunction with their local gatherings and reunion group meetings.

*"Sponsorship is the act of your revisiting The Walk to Emmaus experience with the person whom God has laid upon your heart. Sponsorship is one of the most important aspects of The Walk to Emmaus and must be taken seriously. Sponsorship requires extensive prayer, diligent thought, careful planning and follow-through. The strength of an Emmaus Community is a direct result of its sponsorship practices." (a)*

2007 SPONSOR and PILGRIM applications can be downloaded from our website @ [www.hnec.org](http://www.hnec.org), received via email through [communications@hnec.org](mailto:communications@hnec.org), or requested by telephone at 281.225.9831.

Please PRINT or TYPE applications, especially the email address. Sponsors should encourage Pilgrims to request three different Walk dates and to reserve those dates on their calendars. Walks are filled as applications are received and it is recommended that applications be filed three months in advance to ensure first choice of Walk dates. Walk placement **cannot** be reserved via email or telephone call--only by postmark on application.

**BEING A DAY SERVANT**

In the position of "day servant", Fourth Day members have the flexibility of working individual days on Walks rather than committing to an entire weekend of Team service. Men and women can work on any Walks in the roles of Kitchen Servant or Chapel Servant. Agape Servants can serve in that role on Walks of their same gender only.

**TO BE A DAY SERVANT, FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS:**

1. Download an application from the web at [www.hnec.org](http://www.hnec.org).
2. Choose the Walk number, Walk day(s), and role(s) you want to work.
3. Send in the application form to the HNEC address listed on the form.

The Servant Team Coordinator (STC) for each Walk will review the applications. The STCs will then contact individuals and fill the needed positions on their Walks. If you are asked and agree to serve, you will submit the Walk fee of \$25 per day to the Servant Team Coordinator.

*Please note that the \$25 fee is required because Day Servants are subject to the same Walk expenses, such as insurance and use of the facilities, as are the weekend Team members. HNEC is charged per head by Kaiserhof for every Team member, whether weekend team or Day Servant.*

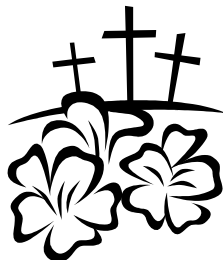

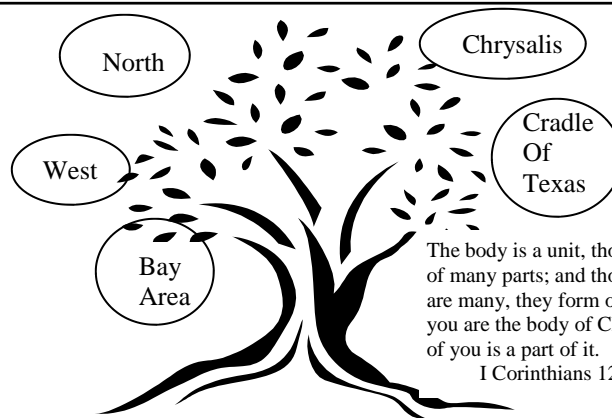
Fourth Day members are encouraged to submit articles to be published in the *Pilgrim's Journey*.
