Sponsor and Pilgrim Applications

SPONSOR and PILGRIM applications can be downloaded from our website @ www.hnec.org, received via email through registrar@hnec.org, or requested by telephone at 281.345.7977.

Please PRINT or TYPE applications, especially the email address. Sponsors should encourage Pilgrims to request three different Walk dates and to reserve those dates on their calendars. Walks are filled as applications are received and it is recommended that applications be filed three months in advance to ensure first choice of Walk dates. Walk placement **cannot** be reserved via email or telephone call--only by postmark on application.

HNEC BOARD - TEAM SELECTION NEWS

DAY SERVANT INFORMATION

GENERAL EXPLANATION

Five former full-time servant group positions have been replaced with Day Servant positions. Therefore, instead of one person working the full Walk weekend for a given team position, we have 3-4 persons working one day each for that same position. This allows more Fourth Day to be able to participate in Team Service. A Day Servant position is an official Team position and therefore a pro-rated Team walk fee of \$25 per day is required.

WHAT IS A DAY SERVANT?

1. An official team member of one of the servant groups (Chapel, Agape, or Kitchen)
2. Signs up to work individual days of a Walk.
3. Anyone (male or female) can work any Walk (either Mens' or Womens').
4. Works the hours as designated by the Head of their Servant Group but does NOT spend the night at the facility.
5. Receives 1/4 of a Walk of Team Service credit for each day served.
6. Can work multiple Walks in the same year.
7. Can work multiple days on the same Walk.



A DAY SERVANT IS NOT...

1. An individual who shows up at random, without notice, at the Walk site.
2. A spectator for events. If you are chosen to serve, you must fulfill the duties of the servant role for the entire day.
3. To be confused with individuals or groups who participate in Community Servanthood activities.

DAY SERVANT TEAM APPLICATION

Team Selection is accepting applications to work as day servants in the roles of Chapel Servants, Agape Servants, and Kitchen Servants. An application form is available for download from the website (www.hnec.org) AND, for your convenience, a form is also included in this newsletter (*see next page/back of this page*).

HOW TO APPLY

1. Complete the form and submit to: **HNEC Registrar, 15201 Mason Road, #1000-321, Cypress, TX 77433**. If selected, you will be contacted and then asked to submit the Walk fee. **OR**
2. Complete the form and submit to teamselection@hnec.org via email. If selected, you will be contacted and then asked to submit the Walk fee. **OR**
3. Contact the Servant Team Coordinator of the Walk that you are interested in working (prior to completing an application form). If the STC calls you back and confirms you to work, complete the Day Servant Application and send in to the HNEC Registrar, along with the \$25 fee per day. **OR**
4. Send an email request to teamselection@hnec.org with your information (including Walk number, position desired, and day of the week that you want to work). This will be forwarded on to the STC of the Walk Team for which you are applying, and the process will continue as in #3 above.

FROM THE SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

I received an email recently that I'd like to share. It helps us understand how we are called to love and serve Christ in the world. The author writes:

“I recently visited a fast-growing church in Minnesota to learn from their staff. One of the phrases that I heard while I was there was, “We want our members to wear aprons, not bibs.” Here is what they meant:

Bibs are for people who only want to be fed.

Bibs are for those who are not yet ready or willing to feed themselves.

Bibs are for those who are more interested in being served than in serving.

Bibs are for those who insist that the church exists for them and their needs.

Bibs are for babies in the faith, those who haven't caught God's vision for the church, or those who are not yet of faith.



Aprons are for those who have a heart to serve others in Jesus' name.

Aprons are for those who know that they are the church.

Aprons are for those who don't mind getting their hands dirty.

Aprons are for those who take the time daily to feed their spiritual hunger.

Aprons are for those who are growing in faith, and who hunger to help others grow.

Church growth consultant, Wim Am, interviewed thousands of Christians in America several years ago and asked them why they thought the church existed. 88% said, “The church exists to serve my needs and the needs of my family.” In other words, 88% of Christians in America are still wearing bibs!

On the night when He was betrayed, just hours before He was crucified, the very Son of God took off his outer garments, wrapped a towel around his waist and washed his disciples' feet. When He was done, He said, “I have just given you an example to follow.” In other words Jesus called his disciples to wear aprons, not bibs.

In Matthew, Jesus is recorded as saying, “For even I, the son of Man came here not to be served but to serve others, and to give my life as a ransom for many.” (Matthew 20:28). He also said, If you cling to your life, you will lose it; but if you give it up for Me, you will find it.” Matthew 16:25...

Jesus calls us to wear aprons – not bibs.

Till the currents deem.*

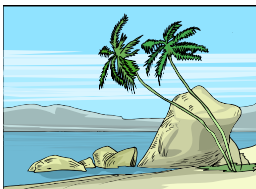
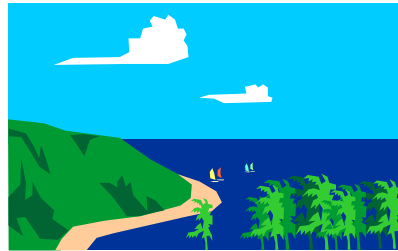

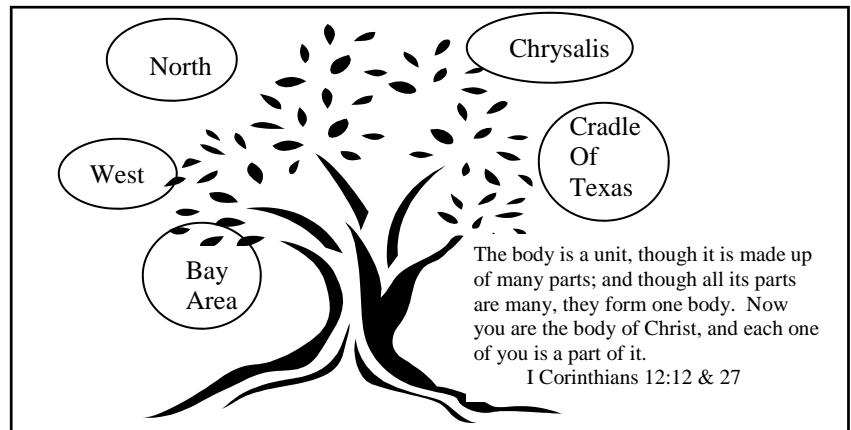
