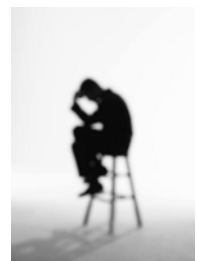

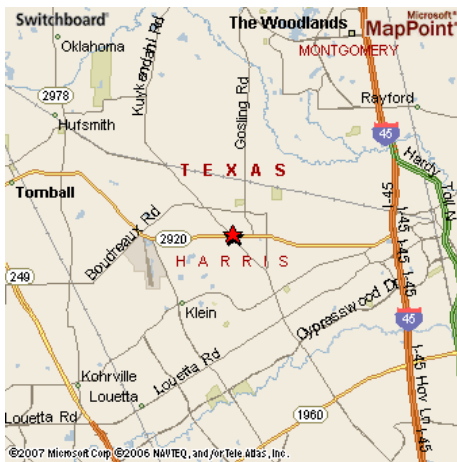

**PURVIS HARPER**

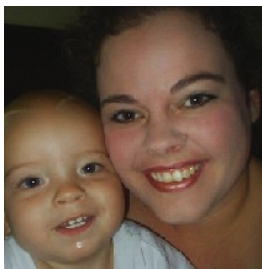

**HOUSTON NORTH EMMAUS COMMUNITY PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES  
TO BE VOTED ON BY THE COMMUNITY AT THE 2007 ANNUAL MEETING  
SATURDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2007 - KLEIN UMC  
(Proposed changes appear in BOLD CAPS within the text.)**

**Article Three - Membership**

**Section 1.** All persons who have completed the three-day experience of the Walk to Emmaus sponsored by this corporation shall be members of this corporation. The Secretary of this corporation shall include their names, **ELECTRONIC AND PHYSICAL** addresses, and telephone numbers on the official directory of the corporation.

**Section 2.** Persons who have completed the Walk to Emmaus sponsored by another Emmaus Community or who have completed another expression of this three-day Christian experience, such as Cursillo, Tres Dias or Chrysalis, that is recognized by The Upper Room Emmaus Movement may become members of this corporation by participating in the activities of this corporation and requesting the Secretary of this corporation to include their names, **ELECTRONIC AND PHYSICAL** addresses, and telephone numbers on the official directory of the corporation.

**Article Four - Board of Directors**

**Section 5.** The term of office for an elected director begins at the **DECEMBER MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND ENDS AT THE DECEMBER MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS** three (3) years hence, or until the director's successor is elected and qualified.

## FRONT ROW GOD

“And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.” Ephesians 3:17b-21 (NIV)

First off, there are a couple of things you need to know:

1. Michael W. Smith is my all-time favorite Christian artist, going all the way back to the beginning of his career/ministry circa 1983.
2. I attended his recent concert on September 7th for my birthday.

My friend Ruth and I had tickets on the tenth row, in the middle of the section to the left of the stage. When we arrived, someone was sitting in our seats. We informed the usher—a very nice guy named Gary, a KSBJ radio station volunteer--of our dilemma. Instead of trying to deal with folks in the middle of the section, Gary instructed us to sit in two empty seats that were at the end of the row on the aisle. Of course, pretty soon the owners of those seats arrived. Gary told them to sit in the two empty seats directly behind us. They were NOT happy. Ruth and I were obliging and switched places with them. (EXAMPLE: Call to Discipleship.)

There we were...concert refugees, now in our third set of seats. I figured eventually we would have to confront the “perpetrators” in our seats. And I was ready! I had several lovely little things to say to them:

“Hey, you idiots, can't you read?”

“Hey, you jerks, get out of our seats!”

“What gives you the right to take our seats? Didn't your momma teach you any manners or respect?” (EXAMPLE: Discipleship Denied)

While these thoughts were bouncing around in my head and my blood pressure was rising, Ruth and Gary were having a conversation. Gary told Ruth, “If these people show up, I'm taking you to the front row!” Ruth gave me the news. I put my purse under the seat and started to sit down. Then I thought, “HEY, wait a minute! What am I doing? I don't want to sit here!” I picked up my purse and stood up. About 10 seconds later, the owners of the seats showed up. Gary took Ruth by the arm and said, “WE'RE GOING TO THE FRONT ROW!” Ruth turned to me and said, “Come on!”

I was in a state of shock. IT'S MY BIRTHDAY!!!! I'M AT A MICHAEL W. SMITH CONCERT! I'M GOING TO THE FRONT ROW!!! (Run down the aisle....) IT'S MY BIRTHDAY!!!! I'M AT A MICHAEL W. SMITH CONCERT! I'M SITTING ON THE FRONT ROW!!! (On the piano side of the stage, 20 feet from M.W.S.)

Every time I replay this story over in my head, I am amazed. I can't believe it happened. The seating situation had left me mad, frustrated, and disappointed. People I don't even know had ruined the evening. They had spoiled my birthday. (Wah! Wah!)

Then...GOD.

“Hey, Rhonda! I know how much you love Smitty and his music. Let me give you something you didn't ask for, something you didn't pay for, something beyond your wildest dreams! Happy Birthday, Rhonda!”

The next time somebody asks me why I believe in God, I'm going to point back to this night, when I was tossed around, rejected, disappointed, frustrated, and truly not even acting or thinking like Christ. I'm going to remember that God found us in the **back** and took us to the **front**.

He's like that, you know...my “Front Row God.” Won't you let Him be the same for you?

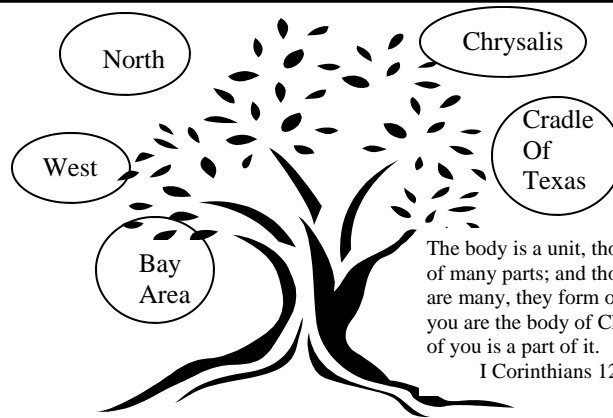
